Language ability	Korean track	TOPIK 3 or more (expiration date after Mar. 1, 2023) ※ Failure to meet the above criteria, applicants must complete the Korean Language Course additionally for 1 year - 2 hours per day (17:00~19:00), 10 hours per week, 20 weeks per semester - Course fee: 1,200,000KRW per semester ※ Applicants who have not got TOPIK 3 cannot apply for the Transfer to 4th year
	English track	TOEFL 530, CBT 197, IBT 71, IELTS 5.0, TEPS 600 or over(expiration date after Mar. 1, 2023)
